

OBJECTIVE(S)

To remove invasive species and reduce erosion on the property in effort to reforest with native Hawaiian species with long term goals of establishing agricultural production, community demonstration agriculture and agroforestry sites throughout the property while maintaining the Kukaniloko Birthing Stone cultural sites.

Conservation Cover(327)

Conservation Cover (Lifespan 5 years) are permanent herbaceous plantings which can accomplish a wide variety of conservation objectives. This practice is to be implemented in combination with practices 460 and 466 to reduce erosion associated with land clearing and land smoothing activities. The technical specifications for this conservation cover will be followed as described on the customized Implementation Requirements (IR) designed for this field(s).

Land Clearing(460)

Land Clearing (Lifespan 10 years) is used whenever removal of trees, stumps and other vegetation is required, including both woody and herbaceous plants. This practice is to be implemented to create a space for the stockpiling of boulders for future erosion control, property boundary, and pathway delineation throughout the property. The technical specifications for this land clearing practice will be followed as described in the Statement of Work specific to this site.

Land Smoothing(466)

Land Smoothing (Lifespan 10 years) is used to remove irregularities on the land surface by utilizing special equipment, where irregularities interfere with the application of needed soil and water conservation and management practices. The purpose of this practice is to level the land previously cleared, as needed, for the stockpiling of boulders intended for future erosion control, property boundary, and pathway delineation throughout the property. The technical specifications for this land clearing practice will be followed as described in the Statement of Work specific to this site.

Applying plant residues or other suitable materials to the land surface.

Vegetative Barrier(601)

Vegetative Barrier (Lifespan 5 years) are strips of stiff, dense vegetation established along the general contour of a slope. This practice is intended to provide additional erosion prevention measures to those planned by the Department of Transportation's (DOT) Temporary Erosion and Permanent BMP Plan (PID 521). Practice location and extent are subject to change based on the DOT's final plans and implementation. The technical specifications for this vegetative barrier practice will be followed as described on the customized Implementation Requirements (IR) designed for this field(s).

Woody Residue Treatment(384)

Woody Residue Treatment (Lifespan 10 years) is employed where woody residues or slash require treatment to mitigate resource concerns or facilitate other management activities. This practice is included as a follow-up practice to the Land Clearing (460) practice, as required in the practice standard. The technical specifications for this woody residue treatment practice will be followed as described on the customized Implementation Requirements (IR) designed for this field(s).




